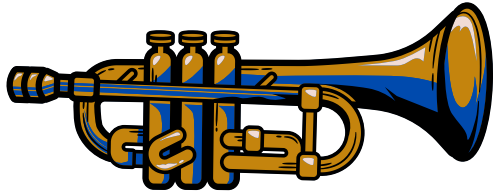

## Dr. Kefa N. N. Matwetwe

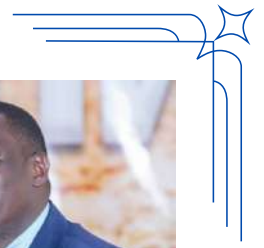

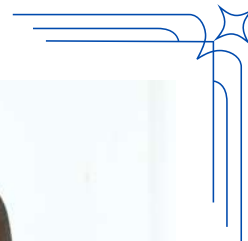
# Guest Speaker: Pr. Bosco Tungaraza

# Guest Speaker: Ev. Peter Mandago



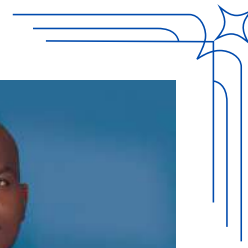

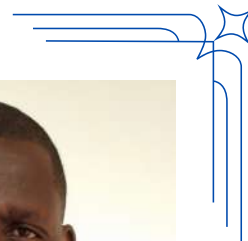

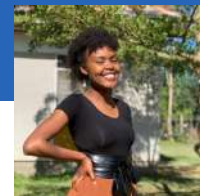
